LEE HARVEY OSWALD - VICTIM

At 3:43 a.m., February 27, 1965, an unidentified female telephoned the Dallas Office of the FBI. She said she was the same woman who had called this office at 2:12 a.m. one Saturday morning and advised that Lee Harvey Oswald would be killed.

The caller stated she believed the officers escorting Ruby to the courtroom for a sanity hearing during the forthcoming week should have their guns drawn because there are many people in Dallas who would like to see Ruby dead. She stated Ruby would attempt to get an officer's gun and shoot himself. She said she had come to Dallas from New Jersey to furnish this information. The same woman called again at 3:50 a.m. and repeated the above.

Deputy Sheriff C. M. Jones, Dallas County Sheriff's Office, was advised of the above at 8:51 a.m., February 27, 1965.

The Dallas Office has no information concerning any female caller with reference to Lee Harvey Oswald being killed.
