For the information of the Laboratory, CAINE cannot read or write by himself. He has only limited knowledge of basic ABC's and although he can print, he cannot write his ABC's and the enclosed writing had to be dictated to him, and in certain instances had to be shown how to write certain letters.

He stated he knows how to write his own name by himself, but this is the limit of his writing ability. CAINE is right-handed and attempts were made to have him write left-handed with negative results.
