NEW YORK BY RETURN TELETYPE ADVISE STATUS OF INVESTIGATION  
IN CONTACT WITH THE NEW YORK JOURNAL AMERICAN AND DOROTHY  
KILGALLIN CONCERNING LEAK OF RUBY'S TESTIMONY BEFORE CHIEF  
JUSTICE WARREN. INVESTIGATION REQUESTED OF NEW YORK IS AN  
IMPORTANT PHASE OF THE INVESTIGATION AND IS TO BE HANDLED  
IMMEDIATELY TO FACILITATE LABORATORY EXAMINATIONS IF PERTINENT  
DOCUMENTS OBTAINED. AS THE PRESIDENT'S COMMISSION HAS ALREADY  
PURNISHED THE INITIAL REPORT TO PRESIDENT JOHNSON REGARDING THE  
ASSASSINATION, ALL PHASES OF INVESTIGATION PENDING MUST BE
