Re Chicago teletype to the Bureau, 1/4/67.

For the information of Dallas, [redacted] Chicago, telephonically contacted this Office three times the evening of 1/3/67. She advised that she is a relative of RUBY, had practically raised him, and about five or six months ago received a letter from him. She said RUBY requested that the contents not be revealed until 1969 but that she felt in view of his death on 1/3/67, she could now make the contents available to the FBI.

Indices of the Chicago Office are negative regarding [redacted] was interviewed by Chicago Agents 1/3/67, at which time she denied relationship with him. She provided the following information concerning RUBY and the alleged letter:

She met RUBY through her son, [redacted] several years ago and that he frequently visited at her home. She last saw RUBY in Chicago about two years ago. She was unable to provide an accurate description of RUBY particularly with regard to age, stating that he should be about 25 or 26 years old at the present time.

[redacted] speech was rambling and disjointed. She appeared to be mentally disturbed and to have been drinking.

[redacted] maintained that she had received alleged letter but refused to furnish it or divulge contents.

[redacted] was reinterviewed this date by Chicago Agents. She was even more incoherent than during the previous interview and definitely appeared to be inebriated. In today's interview she still maintained she had received the letter but that it was only a short time ago. For the first time, she stated she had turned it over to her attorney, [redacted] for safekeeping without revealing its contents.

[redacted] son, [redacted] Chicago, located at his place of employment, [redacted] Chicago, this date. [redacted] who his mother states was responsible for her meeting RUBY, stated that he absolutely did not know RUBY, nor had he ever had any contact with him whatsoever.

With regard to his mother, he said that she is an alcoholic who has been arrested on several occasions by the Chicago Police Department and who has attempted suicide twice. When drinking, she is a chronic trouble-maker who apparently enjoys the attention she gets when creating a disturbance. He considers her to have pyromaniacal tendencies. He stated that she has previously "made up stories" but he has never known her to have previously contacted any law enforcement body with her fabrications.

For the information of the Bureau, [redacted] states correct spelling of family name is [redacted]

In view of the above, Chicago is taking no further action in this matter, UACB.
