Enclosed are ten copies of LHM based on the allegation that JANET CONFORTO, aka "JADA", formerly employed as a "stripper" by RUBY, made a statement prior to the assassination of President KENNEDY on 11/22/63, that RUBY's night club would not be open that night. The statement was allegedly made in connection with an accident she had with one CHARLES E. BURNS, employee of Texas Instruments, Inc. according to Mr. FLOYD E. PURVIS - (former SA), Security Officer, Texas Instruments, Inc. "Indications are that the New Orleans DA has been, or soon will be, in touch with Mr. BURNS." The basis for Mr. PURVIS' statement that the New Orleans DA has been or will be in contact with BURNS is not further explained.

The Bureau will note that contrary to information in Mr. PURVIS' letter, there is no record that Mr. WILLIAM V. WALSH, an employee of Texas Instruments, did in fact report this matter to the Dallas Office, as stated. It is noted that Mr. PURVIS, himself, however, was in contact with the Dallas Office on 11/26/63, regarding the accident in question.

It will further be noted that "JADA" had ceased employment with RUBY sometime prior to the assassination which would seem to discredit the allegation that she made the statement that the night club would be open that night.

No further action is being taken.
