(WARREN COMMISSION)

DALLAS--THE WARREN COMMISSION WILL HEAR TESTIMONY TUESDAY THAT FOUR, NOT THREE, SHOTS WERE FIRED INTO PRESIDENT KENNEDY'S OPEN-TOP LIMOUSINE LAST NOV. 22.

JAMES FICHAPE WORRELL, 20, SAID HE HAD BEEN CALLED BEFORE THE COMMISSION TO TESTIFY ABOUT WHAT HE SAW AND HEARD NEAR THE TEXAS SCHOOLBOOK DEPOSITORY THE DAY KENNEDY WAS SLAIN AND GOV. JOHN CONNALLY WAS INJURED.

"I HEARD FOUR SHOTS--I DON'T CARE WHAT THEY SAY."

WORRELL WAS ONE OF FOUR DALLAS COUNTY MEN CALLED TO APPEAR BEFORE THE COMMISSION NEXT TUESDAY. BOB JACKSON OF THE DALLAS TIMES HERALD, A PHOTOGRAPHER IN A PRESS POOL CAR THAT WAS THE THIRD VEHICLE BEHIND KENNEDY, WAS ONE OF THOSE ASKED TO APPEAR.

ALL FOUR OF THE MEN WERE IN THE VICINITY OF THE ASSASSINATION. ARNOLD LOUIS ROWLAND, 18, DECLINED TO CONFIRM THAT HE WOULD MAKE THE TRIP TO WASHINGTON.

AMOS LEWIS EVINS SAID HE SAW A MAN NEAR THE DEPOSITORY BUILDING "LEAVING HURRIEDLY AFTER THE SHOOTING." HE SAID "SECRET SERVICE MEN TOLD ME I'D BE IN REAL TROUBLE" IF HE COMMENTED FURTHER ON WHAT HE SAW.

JACKSON CONFIRMED THAT HE WOULD ACCEPT THE INVITATION. HE IS THE PHOTOGRAPHER WHO TOOK THE WIDELY-CIRCULATED PICTURE THAT SHOWS LEE HARVEY OSWALD RECOILING IN PAIN AFTER BEING SHOT BY JACK RUBY. HE WROTE A STORY AFTER THE ASSASSINATION THAT SAID HE WHIRLED AND SAW A RIFLE BARREL IN THE DEPOSITORY WINDOW.
