# Dallasites Offer Views on Report

Many Dallasites agree with the Warren Commission findings, according to a sampling of citizens interviewed by a Times Herald reporter.

Others, including a Dallas policeman, disagree. He said emphatically, "The only part I believe is Kennedy was assassinated. I don't see how anybody could believe it (the report)."

Tom Walter, 4155 Grassmere, said it was as he expected it to be and he agreed with it. "I don't see any evidence to the contrary. The only surprise in the report was that the commission recom-

mended taking some of the responsibility away from the Secret Service."

James Vetter, 2447 Connecticut: "The report was objective. I pretty much agree with its findings. It was the best job that could be done with the evidence presented. However, it took too long for the commission to report its findings."
