Staff Wrote, Edited Study Of JFK Death

WASHINGTON (AP) — The report on the assassination of President Kennedy was staff-written, not the work of any single author, commission officials said Sunday.

Staff members were organized in a half-dozen groups, each handling one broad phase of the investigation. Staff men heard all testimony, studied exhibits, read investigation reports, and in handreds of cases ordered further investigations.

At the drafting stage, they sat in on conferences at which Chief Justice Earl Warren and his fellow, commission members discussed the evidence, reached general conclusions, and indicated the general findings to be enhoused in the report.
