## Kupferman Seeks Study of Probe in Kennedy Slaying

By the Associated Press
Rep. Theodore R. Kupferman,
R-N.Y., says he will ask Congress to take up the question
whether it should investigate the
assassination of President John
F. Kennedy.

Kupferman said he would introduce today a joint resolution under which a committee would review the Warren Commission report and all other available information on the assassination.

If further inquiry were indicated, the same committee would move into a full-scale investigation of both the assassination and the slaying of assassin Lee Harvey Oswald.

In announcing his plans, Kupferman noted the recent challenges, in books and other publications, to the Warren Commission findings that Oswald acted alone in the assassination.
