THE FIRST INSTALLMENT OF WILLIAM MANCHESTER'S ACCOUNT OF THE
ASSASSINATION SAID THE CODE NAMES WERE USED WHENEVER THE FIRST
FAMILY LEFT THE WHITE HOUSE. THE WHITE HOUSE BECAME "CASTLE"
AND WHEREVER THE PRESIDENT WAS AT ANY GIVEN MOMENT WAS "CHARCOAL."

B. JOHNSON--VOLUNTEER, LADY BIRD JOHNSON--VICTORIA, PRESIDENTIAL

SALINGER--WAYSIDE. SECRET SERVICE MEN WERE TAGGED WITH SUCH MNAMES
AS DAZZLE, DEACON, DRUMMER, DRESSER AND DASHER.
