ADD KENNEDY BOOK, NEW YORK

ALTHOUGH NEITHER COMMENTED ON THE POSSIBILITY OF COURT ACTION TO STAY FURTHER SERIALIZATION BY STERN, THE POSSIBILITY EXISTED. VANDEN HEUVEL HAS HAD INTERNATIONAL LEGAL EXPERIENCE AND IS PRESIDENT OF THE INTERNATIONAL RESCUE COMMITTEE WHICH AIDS REFUGEES FROM COMMUNISM ALL OVER THE WORLD.

NANNEN SAID LAST WEEK THAT ALTHOUGH THE PASSAGES DELETED BY LOOK "SEEMED TO BE PRIVATE," THEY HAD POLITICAL IMPORTANCE, THAT COULD NOT BE OVERLOOKED IN THE INTEREST OF HISTORICAL ACCURACY. HE SAID HE DID NOT DELETE A SCENE DESCRIBING HOW THE REMOVAL OF A MATTRESS FROM A HOTEL BEDROOM FORCED THE KENNEDYS TO SPEND THEIR LAST NIGHT TOGETHER IN SEPARATE ROOMS BECAUSE THIS INDICATED "LOCAL POLITICAL INTRIGUES."

HOWEVER, NANNEN, WHO PAID \$72,500 TO LOOK FOR SERIALIZATION RIGHTS, SAID TODAY HE WAS "WILLING TO SEE MR. VANDEN HEUVEL" EVEN THOUGH "WE HAVE A CONTRACT WITH LOOK BUT NOT WITH THE KENNEDYS." STERN NEWS EDITOR NORBERT SAKOWSKI ADDED THAT HE DID NOT SEE HOW MRS. KENNEDY COULD BRING LEGAL ACTION IN GERMANY UNLESS SHE COULD PROVE FALSE STATEMENTS OR LIBELOUS MATTER IN THE SERIALIZATION.
