Says He Overheard Plor on JEK

Faces Grilling

NEW ORLEANS, March 15 ICPD - An insurance sale-man who linked a prominent business executive with a plot to kill President Kennedy today faced cross-examination by defense attorneys.

Perry R. Russo, of Baton Rouge, La., testified during a preliminary hearing yesterday that he heard Clay L. Shaw Lee Harvey Oswald and allot David W. Ferrie conspire to kill the President.

The lestimony came on the opening day of a hearing to determine if Dist. Atty. Jim Garrison has sufficient evidence hold and try Mr. Shaw on the conspiracy charge.

'INFORMER'

Mr. Russo apparently was the "confidential informer" Mr. Garrison said sat in on the purported assassination plot late in the summer of 1963 in New Orleans.

He said he learned of the plot after a party in Mr. Ferrie's apartment in mid-September, 1963.

At the time of the alleged assassination plot, he said, he was a college student in New Orleans. He said he met Mr. Ferrie in 1960 and visited him several times in New Orleans.

Defense Attorney F. Irvin Dymond asked the three-judge panel presiding over the hearing to subpena personal and academic records relating to Mr. Russo.

Records from Tulane and Loyola Universities and Equitable Life Assurance Society, where Mr. Russo worked, were asked for about mid-afternoon yesterday. The court then recessed until today so the records could be obtained.

Mr. Russo testified he saw Oswald, Mr. Ferrie and Mr. Shaw, whom he said he knew as "Clem Bertrand," on one occasion — the party at which Mr. Ferrie discussed assassination. He also said he saw Oswald once in Mr. Ferrie's apartment cleaning a / bolt action rifle.

· Ferrie told Shaw and Oswald that an attempt on the President's life should involve two or three persons, one or two of them to create a diversion, and the third "a good shot,"

• Ferrie said one of the assassins would have to be sacrificed and the others should he "in the public eye" on the day of the assassination.

· Ferrie pointed out he was a pilot and it might be possible to escape to Mexico and then to Brazil or even Cuba after the shooting.

· Ferrie discussed "triangulation of cross-fire" and similar ballistics subjects in detail.

Mr. Russo said Mr. Ferrie. was generally considered the leader of the group and was obsessed with President
