 RUSSO SAID HE HAD ALWAYS BEEN HAUNTED BY THE THOUGHT THAT OSWALD  
 MIGHT BE THE MAN HE ALLEGEDLY SAW CONSPIRING WITH SHAW AND PILOT  
 DAVID FERRIE IN FERRIE'S APARTMENT IN SEPTEMBER, 1963.

"THE FACE WAS ALWAYS FAMILIAR, MR. DYMOND," HE SAID. "I MADE  
 REMARKS TO MY FRIENDS, 'I THINK I KNOW THIS MAN.'"

DYMOND ASKED HIM REPEATEDLY WHY HE DID NOT GO TO THE SECRET  
 SERVICE, THE FBI OR THE WARREN COMMISSION.

"VERY FRANKLY, I WAS TRYING TO GET OUT OF SCHOOL," RUSSO SAID.  
 "I WAS NO AUTHORITY ON ANYTHING AND I'M STILL NOT. AT THAT TIME, I  
 WAS 21 OR 22 AND I WAS NOT GOING TO SIT DOWN AND FIGHT THE FEDERAL  
 GOVERNMENT."
