JFK 'Plot' Witness Newly Hypnotized

NEW ORLEANS, March 17 (AP)-The coroner of Orleans

Parish (county) testified today that Perry R. Russo, the state witness who says he heard Clay Shaw conspiring to kill President Kennedy, had been hypnotized in his office two days before the current courtroom proceedings began.

Dr. Nicholas Chella sald... Russo, a 25-year-old insurance, saleaman, underwent hypnosis through the use of sodium pentothal on Feb. 28 at Mercy Hospital, on March 2 in the office of Assistant District Attorney Charles Ward, and on March 12 in the coroner's office.

Russo told the three-judge criminal district court panel Tuesday that he heard Shaw, Lee Harvey Oswald and David W. Ferrie talking in September 1953 of how to kill President John F. Kennedy.

Alvin Oser, an assistant to District Attorney Jim Garrison, began questioning Chetta about details of Russo's comments while under hypnosis. The defense objected.

Your honor, he's getting out of the realm of sanity of this witness and is trying to bolster the credibility of the witness and I object," said F. Irvin

The preliminary hearing was called by Garrison to determine

if sufficient evidence exists to fake Snaw, a 54-year-old retired

executive, to trial.

Gardson has stated he will prove that an assassination complracy was hatched in New Orleans and culminated in the death of Kennedy.

BRINGS RECORDS

At the start of today's hearing, C. W. Johnson, district director of the U.S. Immigration and Naturalization Service, brought two documents into the court after being subpoenaed, by the defense.

He had a record of a Cuban named Manuel Garcia Gonzales who entered this country as a refugee and another of a Manuel Garcia Gonzales who came to the United States as a temporary visitor. It was not clear if the records pertained to

the same individual.
