(KENNEDY ASSASSINATION)  
 MOSCOW--NEW ORLEANS DISTRICT ATTORNEY JIM GARRISON PLANS TO MAKE "MANY MORE" ARRESTS IN THE KENNEDY ASSASSINATION CASE ASK FOR HELP FROM FEDERAL AUTHORITIES AND OTHER STATES, TASS SAID TODAY.  
 THE REPORT SAID GARRISON TOLD TASS CORRESPONDENT S. LOSEV AND NOVOSTI PRESS AGENCY CORRESPONDENT J. BOROVOK THAT THE PLOT WAS NOT ORIGINALLY DIRECTED AGAINST THE LATE U.S. PRESIDENT "BUT THEN IT TOOK A COURSE SIMILAR TO A ROCKET WHEN IT GOES OUT OF CONTROL AND HITS QUITE A DIFFERENT TARGET."  
 TASS SAID THAT "WHEN ASKED WHETHER HE WAS GOING TO MAKE OTHER ARRESTS, GARRISON REPLIED THAT THERE WOULD BE MANY MORE BUT NOT IN THE NEAR FUTURE... IN CONCLUSION... (HE) SAID THAT IN A LATER STAGE OF THE INVESTIGATION HE WOULD ASK FOR ASSISTANCE BY INVESTIGATING AGENCIES IN OTHER STATES AND THE FEDERAL AUTHORITIES."  
 "BUT FOR THE TIME BEING HE WAS NOT GOING TO TRANSFER THE INVESTIGATION TO ANYONE," TASS SAID.  
 THE REPORT SAID GARRISON DENIED TO THE TWO SOVIET NEWS AGENCY CORRESPONDENTS THAT ANY FOREIGN COUNTRY HAD ANYTHING TO DO WITH THE KENNEDY ASSASSINATION. SPECULATION THAT CUBA HAD BEEN BEHIND THE PLOT HAD BEEN A KEY FACTOR IN SOVIET PRESS HANDLING OF THE GARRISON INVESTIGATION.
