**Report Shaw  
 Quitting U.S.**

London, March 17 (UPI)—  
 The Daily Mail reported today  
 that Clay Shaw, under indict-  
 ment in the New Orleans inves-  
 tigation into the assassination  
 of President Kennedy, planned  
 to move to England next  
 month.

The newspaper said Shaw  
 was well known in London  
 society and had once dined  
 with Winston Churchill. It  
 quoted socialite Mrs. Owen  
 Harris as saying Shaw had  
 been a house guest of hers and  
 that he was a friend of an un-  
 named member of Parliament.
