PUT UP OR SHUT UP

New Orleans District Attorney Jim Garrison (called "flamboyant" by some who know him well) has been trying for months to build a case for a "conspiracy" to murder President John F. Kennedy Nov. 22, 1963.

Both the National Broadcasting Co. and the Columbia Broadcasting System have televised programs showing in depth the holes in Garrison's alleged case and exposing some of the questionable tactics he has employed in putting the thing together.

Garrison And NBC

NBC has offered Garrison TV time to rebut the NBC charges, if he can. Garrison says he'll take up the offer—but only if he gets one hour of prime time and performs without a panel of persons to ask him questions.

That is transparently dirty pool; an attempt to rig the program in favor of Garrison all down the line. — If he stands pat on these proposed conditions, why should NBC have any further dealings with him?
