(KENNEDY ASSASSINATION)

NEW ORLEANS--DIST. JUDGE EDWARD A. HAGGERTY JR. TODAY RULED DIST. ATTY. JIM GARRISON COULD GO AHEAD WITH AN "EQUAL TIME" REPORT ON HIS KENNEDY ASSASSINATION PROBE OVER NATIONAL TELEVISION.

ATTORNEYS FOR CLAY L. SHAW, THE MAN GARRISON CHARGED WITH CONSPIRING TO ASSASSINATE PRESIDENT KENNEDY, ASKED HAGGERTY TO BAR GARRISON FROM THE TV APPEARANCE.

THE HALF-HOUR PROGRAM IS SCHEDULED OVER NBC SATURDAY, TO ALLOW THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY TO ANSWER CRITICISM IN AN NBC SPECIAL PROGRAM.

DEFENSE ATTORNEYS CLAIMED THE PROGRAM WOULD VIOLATE RULES PROHIBITING PUBLIC DISCUSSION OF THE CASE IN ADVANCE OF THE TRIAL.

ALTHOUGH HAGGERTY REFUSED TO BAR GARRISON FROM APPEARING, HE APPARENTLY DID NOT RULE OUT THE POSSIBILITY THAT HE MIGHT FIND THE PROGRAM A VIOLATION OF THE COURT RULES AFTER HE SEES WHAT GARRISON HAS TO SAY.

"THIS COURT FAILS TO APPRECIATE THAT A VIOLATION WILL OCCUR UNTIL IT DOES," HE SAID.
