Garrison Probe

NEW ORLEANS—Two television newsmen who investigated the controversial Kennedy assassination probe appeared here to face charges filed by District Attorney Jim Garrison.

Walter Sheridan, 41, of Washington, an investigative reporter for the National Broadcasting Co., surrendered at the criminal district court clerk's office and posted \$5000 bond.

Before he left, Sheridan, charged with trying to bribe a Garrison witness into changing his story, was subpoenaed to appear before the Orleans Parish grand jury Wednesday.

Richard Townley, a reporter for WDSU-TV in New Orleans, an NBC affiliate, stood in criminal district court to plead innocent to a similar bribery charge.

• John Otis Sumrall, a Negro civil rights worker in Mississippi, was convicted by an all-white Federal jury of refusing induction into the armed services. U.S. District Judge Harold Cox sentenced him to five years in prison and fined him \$2500.

• A coroner's jury in Milton, Fla., blamed three convicts for deliberately starting a fire in a prison road camp that killed 37 prisoners Sunday night.

• A court order was issued to allow the Philadelphia District Attorney's office to catalogue the contents of a safe deposit box rented by Harry J. Karafin, the former Philadelphia Inquirer reporter accused of using his position as a reporter for blackmail and extortion.
