(KENNEDY ASSASSINATION)

NEW ORLEANS--PRE-TRIAL-MANEUVERS BY ATTORNEYS FOR CLAY L. SHAW, ACCUSED OF PLOTTING TO ASSASSINATE PRESIDENT KENNEDY, COULD END BY SEPT. 18 AND SHAW COULD GO TO TRIAL BY EARLY OCTOBER.

DIST. JUDGE EDWARD A. HAGGERTY JR. YESTERDAY INDICATED HE EXPECTED TO DISPOSE OF ALL PRELIMINARY PROCEEDINGS BY THAT DATE.

SHAW'S LAWYERS EARLIER THIS SUMMER FILED A MOTION TO QUASH THE CONSPIRACY INDICTMENT AGAINST THE FORMER MANAGING DIRECTOR OF THE NEW ORLEANS INTERNATIONAL TRADE MART, BUT IT BOGGED DOWN IN LEGAL TECHNICALITIES. HAGGERTY THEN ORDERED THE DEFENSE TO FILE AN AMENDED MOTION.

THE AMENDED MOTION HAD NOT BEEN FILED BY SHAW'S ATTORNEYS YESTERDAY, AND HAGGERTY SET AN AUG. 30 DEADLINE FOR IT. HE GAVE THE STATE UNTIL SEPT. 10 TO ANSWER.

DIST. ATTY. JIM GARRISON CHARGED THAT SHAW, 54, CONSPIRED WITH LEE HARVEY OSWALD AND THE LATE DAVID FERRIE TO ASSASSINATE THE PRESIDENT IN 1963.

IF HAGGERTY'S PROJECTED DEADLINE FOR PRELIMINARY MOTIONS IS MET, SHAW COULD GO TO TRIAL IN LATE SEPTEMBER OR EARLY OCTOBER.
