District Court Judge Alvin Rubin, in his ruling, said Sheridan would be forced to match legal wits with the Dis-trict Attorney without benefit of a lawyer if he went before the grand jury. At the same time, however, Judge Rubin denied a request by Sheridan, an investigative reporter for the National Broadcasting Co., and Richard Townley. a newsman for

Townley. a newsman for WDSU-TV here, to enjoin Garrison from prosecuting them on charges of public bribery.
