NEW YORK--REP. THEODORE KUPFERMAN, R-N.Y., SAID TODAY HE WOULD DEMAND THAT X-RAYS OF THE BODY OF THE LATE PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY BE MADE AVAILABLE TO "RESPONSIBLE EXPERTS."

KUPFERMAN SAID IN A TELEVISION INTERVIEW (WPIX-TV), HE WOULD INSIST THAT THE U.S. ATTORNEY GENERAL "SO INTERPRET THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT" THAT THE X-RAYS BE RELEASED.

"I BELIEVE THE AMERICAN PEOPLE ARE ENTITLED TO THE FACTS," HE SAID, "AND ONE OF THE THINGS THAT HAS NOT BEEN REVEALED IS THE CONTENTS OF THE X-RAYS AND THE PHOTOGRAPHS OF THE LATE PRESIDENT KENNEDY."

KUPFERMAN SAID THE MATERIAL IS NECESSARY TO DETERMINE IF THE "SINGLE BULLET" THEORY IS VALID.

CRITICS OF THE WARREN COMMISSION REPORT HAVE CONTENDED THAT KENNEDY AND TEXAS GOV. JOHN CONNALLY WERE HIT BY SEPARATE BULLETS, WHICH THEY SAY WOULD INDICATE THE PRESENCE OF MORE THAN ONE ASSASSIN.
