Dallas DA Pulls Out Of JFK Movie

Dallas (AP) — Dallas Distactly. Henry Wade, upset over the public notice given his proposed role in a movie about the assassination of President Kennedy, said he is withdrawing from the project.

"I'm through with it. I'll have nothing to do with the film," Wade told the Dallas Times Herald.

The district attorney earlier this week denied that he had a contract with the film's producer, Robert Larsen of Colorado Springs, Colo., but said that he had discussed the matter with Larsen.

Larsen said he had offered \$20,000 to Wade to appear in the film, "Countdown in Dallas."

Larsen said he had offered \$20.000 to Mrs. Marina Oswald Porter, whose first husabnd, Lee flarvey Oswald, was named by the Warren Commission as Kennedy's assassin, and \$1500 to former Police Chief Jesse Curry. Neither Mrs. Porter nor Curry could be reached for comment. Oswald was killed by Jack Ruby.

"Without Wade and any kind of cooperation down here is Dallas, it would be difficult the produce the authentic picture! wanted to make." Larsen said "It looks now like the film is dead until I can regenerate interest in it. And I will try to do this because I believe in the project."
