NEW YORK (UPI)—ROBERT F. KENNEDY HAS "DONE EVERYTHING HE COULD TO OBSTRUCT" THE INVESTIGATION OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY'S ASSASSINATION, NEW ORLEANS DIST. ATTY. JIM GARRISON CHARGED YESTERDAY.

"IT IS QUITE APPARENT TO ME THAT FOR ONE REASON OR ANOTHER HE DOES NOT WANT THE TRUTH TO BE BROUGHT OUT," GARRISON SAID IN AN INTERVIEW WITH UPI AGENCIES. "PERHAPS HE CAN EXPLAIN BETTER THAN I CAN WHY HIS POLITICAL CAREER IS SO IMPORTANT."

BECAUSE OF KENNEDY'S ALLEGED ATTEMPTS TO OBSTRUCT THE CONTROVERSIAL GARRISON FEELS, "I HAVE TO CONCLUDE THAT HE FEELS THE DEVELOPMENT OF TRUTH ABOUT THE ASSASSINATION, CATCHING THE REAL ASSASSINS OF JACK KENNEDY, WOULD INTERFERE WITH HIS POLITICAL CAREER," DISTRICT ATTORNEY SAID.

GARRISON SAID HE KNOWS THE NAMES OF MEN INVOLVED IN THE ALLEGED PLOT TO ASSASSINATE KENNEDY. HE SAID, "MOST OF THEM ARE IN TEXAS, AND DALLAS PARTICULARLY, WHERE THEY ARE PROTECTED—SOME BY THE DALLAS LAW ENFORCEMENT ESTABLISHMENT, AND T'G, BY THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT."
