Garrison Still Makes Headlines, But Produces No Real Evidence

New Orleans District Attorney Jim Garrison keeps coming up with new, startling revelations in that conspiracy to assassinate President Kennedy—a conspiracy for which, however, the only evidence he has supplied so far is in his own perfervid imagination.

Now he's extended his net to include the Dallas Police Force. Or has he?

"Elements of the Dallas Police Force," Garrison asserted the other day during a visit to publicize a Playboy Magazine interview of him, "were deeply and probably involved."

But if they were "deeply" involved, why the word "probably"? The word "deeply" implies both certainty and extent; the word "probably" implies at least some uncertainty.

The statement is, in short, self-contradictory. It makes no sense.

But then neither does Jim Garrison's entire "case." It provides copy, but it does not provide proof.

Accusations are not evidence, and multiplying accusations does not multiply evidence. Zero times any number is still zero.

Asked to comment on Garrison's latest charge, Jesse E. Curry, who was Dallas police chief at the time of the assassination, noted that none of the other investigations—including the Warren Commission's—had shown anything remotely supporting or even touching on Garrison's allegation.

Let it be remembered, incidentally, that the Warren Commission's finding were based to a considerable extent on the findings of J. Edgar Hoover's FBI.

That means that if there had actually been a conspiracy, J. Edgar Hoover would have to be a fellow-conspirator in covering it up.

Of Garrison, Mr. Curry declares: "I don't know what he is talking about."

Relax. Neither does Garrison.
