(ASSASSINATION)

LOS ANGELES--EDGAR EUGENE BRADLEY, 49, WEST COAST REPRESENTATIVE OF A RADIO EVANGELIST, WAS ARRAIGNED WEDNESDAY IN MUNICIPAL COURT IN CONNECTION WITH A LOUISIANA WARRANT ACCUSING HIM OF CONSPIRING TO KILL PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY AND WAS RELEASED ON HIS OWN RECOGNIZANCE WITHOUT BEING REQUIRED TO POST BAIL.

BRADLEY WHO HAS DENIED ANY INVOLVEMENT IN THE ASSASSINATION OF THE PRESIDENT MADE A PRE-ARRANGED SURRENDER TO SHERIFF PETER PITCHESS AND WAS THEN TAKEN BEFORE JUDGE DAVID J. AISENSON FOR THE ARRAIGNMENT. JUDGE AISENSON CONTINUED THE CASE FOR 30 DAYS PENDING EXTRADITION PROCEEDINGS BY LOUISIANA AUTHORITIES. BRADLEY WAS ORDERED TO COME BACK TO COURT JAN. 29 AT 2 P.M.
