Case Pressed In JFK 'Plot'

Los Angeles, Dec. 27 (UPI)—Edgar Eugene Bradley, 49, West Coast representative of a radio evangelist, was arraigned today in Municipal Court on a Louisiana warrant accusing him of conspiring to kill President Kennedy and was released without bail.

Bradley denied any involvement in the assassination. Judge David Aisenon continued the case for 30 days pending extradition proceedings by Louisiana authorities.

The charges were filed by New Orleans District Attorney

Jim Garrison. Bradley was accused of "criminal conspiracy to murder" President Kennedy on Nov. 22, 1963, at Dallas, Tex.

On the day of the assassination, Bradley said, he was on a bus en route to El Paso, Tex., on a business trip for his employer, Dr. Carl McIntire, Cedarwood, N.J., right wing radio evangelist.
