CUMMINGS PEPCRTEDLY TOLD GARRISON'S INVESTIGATORS THAT CUMMINGS PEPERTEDLY TELD GARRISON'S INVESTIGATORS THAT TEN DAYS LATER, CUMMINGS PICKED UP A FARE NEAR JACK RUEY'S APARTMENT IN THE OAK CLIFF SECTION OF DALLAS AND TOOK THEM TO RUBY'S NIGHTCLUB.
