ASSASSINATION 6/11 DA1
 BY BILLY G. JAMES
 UNITED PRESS INTERNATIONAL
 NEW ORLEANS (UPI)--DEFENSE ATTORNEYS MOVE INTO CRIMINAL DISTRICT COURT MONDAY IN AN ATTEMPT TO QUASH A CONSPIRACY INDICTMENT AGAINST CLAY L. SHAW IN CONNECTION WITH THE ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY.

DIST. ATTY. JIM GARRISON, WHO IS CONDUCTING HIS OWN INVESTIGATION INTO THE ASSASSINATION, CLAIMS SHAW CONSPIRED WITH THE LATE LEE HARVEY OSWALD, DAVID FERRIE AND JACK RUBY TO KILL KENNEDY IN DALLAS ON NOV. 22, 1963.

IN WHAT APPEARS TO BE A LENGTHY HEARING, DEFENSE ATTORNEYS HAVE ASK THE COURT TO OVERTURN THE INDICTMENT; PROVIDE A BILL OF PARTICULARS, INCLUDING TIMES, DATES AND PLACES OF THE ALLEGED CONSPIRACY AND TO HAVE SHAW'S PERSONAL BELONGINGS RETURNED.

ATTY. F. IRVIN TYMOND HAS SUBPOENAED 32 WITNESSES TO APPEAR AT THE PRE-TRIAL HEARING. THOSE SUBPOENAED INCLUDE GARRISON, MEMBERS OF HIS LEGAL AND INVESTIGATIVE FORCE, HIS FINANCIAL MAKERS, THE ORLEANS PARISH (COUNTY) GRAND JURY AND SEVEN OF THE EIGHT CRIMINAL DISTRICT JUDGES.

ONLY JUDGE EDWARD A. MAGGERTY JR., WHO WILL PRESIDE OVER MONDAY'S HEARING AND THE ACTUAL TRIAL, ESCAPED SUBPOENA.

MAGGERTY EARLIER CREATED "TRUTH AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEW ORLEANS, INC.," A SECRETIVE GROUP OF NEW ORLEANS BUSINESSMEN FINANCING THE INVESTIGATION, TO FURNISH THE COURT WITH A COMPLETE LIST OF ITS MEMBERS AND THE AMOUNT OF FUNDS ALLOTTED TO THE PROBE.

VILLARD E. ROBERTSON, JOSEPH K. FAULT JR., AND CECIL SHILESTONE, HEADS OF THE GROUP SAY THEY HAVE PUT \$9,000 INTO THE INVESTIGATION SO FAR.

THE BUSINESSMEN FORMED THE ORGANIZATION AFTER GARRISON COMPLAINED THAT PUBLIC RECORDS SHOWING EXPENDITURES OF HIS OFFICE WERE HURTING HIS INVESTIGATION.

GARRISON HAS ALSO BEEN ORDERED TO TURN OVER TO THE COURT RECORDS OF RECEIPTS AND DISBURSEMENTS OF THE PRIVATELY DONATED FUNDS.

IN ANOTHER COURT MONDAY, CRIMINAL DISTRICT JUDGE FRANK SHEA WILL HEAR ARGUMENTS ON MOTIONS BY JEFFERSON PARISH (COUNTY) ATTORNEY DEAN ANDREWS IN WHICH ANDREWS SEEKS TO QUASH HIS PERJURY INDICTMENT AND FOR A SPEEDY TRIAL.

ANDREWS, WHO APPEARED BEFORE THE WARREN COMMISSION, WAS INDICTED BY THE ORLEANS PARISH GRAND JURY.

ANDREWS TOLD THE WARREN COMMISSION THAT A MAN NAMED CLAY BERTRAND ASKED HIM TO DEFEND OSWALD. HE TOLD THE GRAND JURY HE COULD NOT SAY WHETHER THE MYSTERIOUS BERTRAND WAS ACTUALLY SHAW.

GARRISON CLAIMS SHAW AND BERTRAND ARE THE SAME MAN.
