JFK Plot Suspect Lie Test

Edgar Eugene Bradley, 49, of North Hollywood, indicated today he would rely heavily on a lie detector test given him in his plans to escape extradition to New Orleans.

Bradley is charged with criminal conspiracy to commit murder in the President John F. Kennedy assassination probe being conducted by New Orleans Dist. Atty. Jim Garrison.

Results of a lie detector test requested by Bradley and his attorney, and administered by Major Chris Gugas, a Beverly Hills polygraph expert, were revealed at a press conference yesterday at the Beverly Hilton Hotel.

Gugas said he had given Bradley a total of nine examinations and that Bradley was asked seven critical questions:

According to Gugas, Bradley answered seven questions "No". Gugas said he could find no deception, and believed the answers to be truthful.

The questions asked Bradley were:

Were you in Dallas in 1962 or 1963? Were you a part of a plot in any way, to assassinate President John F. Kennedy? Have you ever piloted a plane by taking off or landing one at any time?

Have you ever talked to Lee Harvey Oswald, Jack Ruby or David Ferrie? Have you ever conspired to kill Texas Attorney General Tom McCann (non-existent person)? Were you ever in Scott Airport or New Orleans before 1967?
