JUDGE DELAYS ORDER ON GARRISON WITNESS

BAKERSFIELD (AP) — Superior Court Judge P. Borton delayed Wednesday for two weeks a decision on whether to order Loren Hall of Kern County to appear before a New Orleans grand jury investigating the assassination of President Kennedy.

At the same time, Borton ordered Hall's lawyer and the Kern County district attorney's office to urge New Orleans Dist. Atty. Jim Garrison to come to Bakersfield to take a deposition from Hall. Garrison contends he has uncovered a plot to assassinate the President.

He issued a subpoena for Hall. Garrison contends Hall had dealings with Lee Harvey Oswald and Jack Ruby in Dallas and was in that town for several days in November of 1963. At a brief hearing, Hall said Wednesday he was afraid to return to New Orleans for fear pro-Cuban agents would assassinate him.
