Top Garrison Aide Quits ^{A13}

NEW ORLEANS, March 24 — One of two top legal strategists in District Attorney Jim Garrison's investigation of the assassination of President John F. Kennedy has quit his job to join a law firm in another city.

Garrison's investigation has dwindled to only a trickle of the money a group of wealthy businessmen pledged to him in February, 1967. Millionaire businessman Willard Robertson said contributions had dropped about 50 per cent over the last month.

Richard Burnes would neither confirm nor deny reports that he had become disenchanted with the investigation or had left for a better salary.

James Alcock, the other legal strategist on Garrison's team, said Burnes accepted a "lucrative" job. Burnes is now with the Alexandria, La., law firm of Camille Gravel, a Louisiana liberal and former Democratic national committeeman.

It also was learned that a secret fund helping to finance
