L.A. DOCTOR EXTRADITION SOUGHT IN GARRISON PROBE

A Los Angeles physician, has been ordered to appear in Superior Court here next Wednesday for hearing into a request that he be transported to Louisiana in connection with New Orleans District Attorney Jim Garrison's probe of President John F. Kennedy's assassination.

Dr. Drennan, 50, is wanted in New Orleans as a material witness for a Grand Jury hearing there May 29.

Documents sent by Garrison say the Orleans Parish Grand Jury has information that Dr. Drennan, who has offices at 4645 Beverly Blvd., was present in 1963 at discussions concerning the possibilities of assassinating the late President.

Garrison at the same time obtained a subpoena for Clinton Wheat, 55, for the same purpose. Wheat is a former Los Angeles resident at whose home one of the alleged discussions occurred. His whereabouts is reported unknown.

Edgar Eugene Bradley, 49, North Hollywood man accused by Garrison of conspiring to assassinate Kennedy also attended the meeting at Wheat's home, according to a witness in the probe. Bradley is awaiting an extradition hearing June 5.

Superior Court Judge Richard Schauer signed documents ordering Dr. Drennan to show cause Wednesday why he should not be sent to New Orleans.
