Shaw Case
NEW ORLEANS—Defense attorneys for Clay L. Shaw accused District Attorney Jim Garrison's staff of wiretapping, and asked that Attorney General Ramsey Clark be brought in to defend the Warren report.

The statements were contained in motions filed in U.S. District Court in Shaw's battle against an indictment that he conspired to assassinate President John F. Kennedy in the months before the President's murder in Dallas in 1963.

Warhol Improved
NEW YORK — Pop artist Andy Warhol, shot in his studio June 3, was removed from the critical list and is improving steadily, a hospital spokesman said.

Valeria Solanis, 28, the actress charged with shooting him, is undergoing psychiatric examination.
