 NEW ORLEANS (PI)--A THREE-JUDGE FEDERAL PANEL WILL RULE MONDAY  
 WHETHER TO MAKE U.S. ATTY. GEN. RAMSEY CLARK A CO-PLAINTIFF  
 WITH ASSASSINATION CONSPIRACY DEFENDANT CLAY L. SHAW IN A SUIT  
 AGAINST DIST. ATTY. JIM GARRISON.  
 THE PANEL WILL ALSO CONDUCT A PRE-TRIAL CONFERENCE ON ALL  
 MOTIONS FILED IN THE CASE. A HEARING WILL BE HELD NEXT MONTH TO  
 DETERMINE WHETHER GARRISON SHOULD BE ENJOINED FROM PROSECURING  
 SHAW FOR CONSPIRACY IN THE DEATH OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY. GARRISON  
 IS CURRENTLY UNDER A TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER.  
 SHAW'S ATTORNEY, EDWARD F. WEGMANN SAID CLARK SHOULD BE MADE  
 A PARTY IN THE SUIT TO PROTECT THE "INTEREST AND INTEGRITY OF THE  
 UNITED STATES, PRESIDENT JOHNSON AND MEMBERS OF THE WARREN  
 COMMISSION FROM GARRISON'S ATTACKS.  
 WEGMANN ASKED THAT THE WARREN COMMISSION REPORT BE MADE "VALID,  
 ACCURATE AND CORRECT, BINDING AND CONTROLLING UPON, AND ADMISSABLE  
 IN EVIDENCE IN ALL COURTS OF THE UNITED STATES, AND IN PARTICULAR

GARRISON 6/16 DA3  
 NEW ORLEANS (UPI)--A THREE-JUDGE FEDERAL PANEL WILL RULE MONDAY WHETHER TO MAKE U.S. ATTY. GEN. RAMSEY CLARK A CO-PLAINTIFF WITH ASSASSINATION CONSPIRACY DEFENDANT CLAY L. SHAW IN A SUIT AGAINST DIST. ATTY. JIM GARRISON.

THE PANEL WILL ALSO CONDUCT A PRE-TRIAL CONFERENCE ON ALL MOTIONS FILED IN THE CASE. A HEARING WILL BE HELD NEXT MONTH TO DETERMINE WHETHER GARRISON SHOULD BE ENJOINED FROM PROSECURING SHAW FOR CONSPIRACY IN THE DEATH OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY. GARRISON IS CURRENTLY UNDER A TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER.

SHAW'S ATTORNEY, EDWARD F. WEGMANN SAID CLARK SHOULD BE MADE A PARTY IN THE SUIT TO PROTECT THE "INTEREST AND INTEGRITY" OF THE UNITED STATES. PRESIDENT JOHNSON AND MEMBERS OF THE WARREN COMMISSION FROM GARRISON'S ATTACKS.

WEGMANN ASKED THAT THE WARREN COMMISSION REPORT BE MADE "VALID, ACCURATE AND CORRECT, BINDING AND CONTROLLING UPON, AND ADMISSABLE IN EVIDENCE IN ALL COURTS OF THE UNITED STATES, AND IN PARTICULAR, THE CRIMINAL DISTRICT COURT FOR THE PARISH OF ORLEANS..." LOUISIANA STATE JUDGES HAVE SO FAR REFUSED TO ADMIT IT IN PRELIMINARY HEARINGS FOR SHAW.
