**Garrison Probe**

DES MOINES, Iowa—Lillie McMaines signed a deposition denying she went to a New Orleans party attended by Clay Shaw and Lee Harvey Oswald two months before the assassination of President John F. Kennedy.

Mrs. McMaines, 23, signed the deposition in a closed meeting with William Wegmann, an attorney for Shaw. Shaw has been charged with conspiracy in the death of Kennedy by New Orleans District Attorney Jim Garrison.

A chief witness against Shaw, Perry Russo, has testified that Mrs. McMaines, then known as Sandra Moffit, was at a party in September, 1963, which was attended by Shaw and Oswald, the assassin of the President. The party allegedly occurred at the home of David Ferrie another figure in Garrison's investigation who died in 1967.
