NEW ORLEANS--ASSISTANT DIST. ATTY. JAMES ALCOCK SAID TODAY THAT CLAY L. SHAW CANNOT BE TRIED ON CHARGES OF CONSPIRING TO ASSASSINATE PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY UNTIL A WASHINGTON COURT PRESENTS ALL THE EVIDENCE FROM THE KENNEDY AUTOPSY REPORT.

SHAW, A RETIRED NEW ORLEANS BUSINESSMAN, WAS SCHEDULED TO GO ON TRIAL TUESDAY.

ALCOCK SAID HE WILL FILE A MOTION REQUESTING A CONTINUANCE OF THE CASE UNTIL EVIDENCE SUBPOENAED FROM WASHINGTON HAS BEEN PRESENTED.

HE SAID A FEDERAL JUDGE WAS CONDUCTING A HEARING IN WASHINGTON TODAY TO DETERMINE WHETHER THE NATIONAL ARCHIVES MUST BE FORCED TO PRESENT THE AUTOPSY REPORTS TO DIST. ATTY. JIM GARRISON.

THOUGH GARRISON IS DISTRICT ATTORNEY, ALCOCK WAS SUPPOSED TO LEAD THE PROSECUTION AT THE SHAW TRIAL.
