BERTEL JR., ASSISTANT TO GARRISON, TOLD HALLECK THAT PROVING GARRISON'S NEED FOR THE PICTURES WOULD AMOUNT TO TRYING THE SHAW CASE IN WASHINGTON INSTEAD OF NEW ORLEANS. BERTEL ASKED FOR TIME TO THINK IT OVER. HALLECK TOLD HIM IF TWO WEEKS PASSED AND LOUISIANA HAD NOT PROVEN ITS NEED FOR THE X-RAYS AND PHOTOGRAPHS HE WOULD LET THE MATTER DROP.
