**Oswald's Dallas lair for sale** 511

DALLAS, March 13 (UPI) — The Texas School Book Depository, from which Lee Harvey Oswald assassinated President John F. Kennedy with a high-powered rifle, will be sold at auction April 16.

The building is owned by Dallas Trust Corp., of which Col. D. Harold Byrd, an oilman, is principal owner. Extensive development in the western part of downtown Dallas, where the Depository is located, was understood to be the main reason for selling.

The Texas School Book Depository uses the first four floors of the seven story building. The top three floors are empty. The school book depository recently completed a warehouse of its own and does not now need the building.
