HAGGERTY 12/20 DA5
NEW ORLEANS (UPI)--REPRESENTATIVES OF DISTRICT ATTORNEY JIM GARRISON DISCLAIMED SATURDAY ANY PRIOR KNOWLEDGE OF A VICE RAID THAT NETTED CRIMINAL DISTRICT JUDGE EDWARD A. HAGGERTY JR., WHO PRESIDED OVER THE CLAY L. SHAW ASSASSINATION CONSPIRACY TRIAL.

"WE DIDN'T KNOW ANYTHING ABOUT IT UNTIL WE SAW IT ON TELEVISION," SAID ASSISTANT DISTRICT ATTORNEY JAMES L. ALCOCK, THE CHIEF PROSECUTOR OF SHAW ON CHARGES OF CONSPIRING TO KILL PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY.

"IT IS ABSOLUTELY AMAZING THAT PEOPLE ARE SPECULATING THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE IS BEHIND THE RAID," ALCOCK SAID.

THE WHITE HAired JUDGE AND SEVERAL OTHER PERSONS WERE ARRESTED IN THE RAID ON A TULANE AVENUE MOTEL ROOM. HAGGERTY, 56, WAS CHARGED WITH SOLICITING FOR PROSTITUTION, THREE COUNTS OF ASSAULT ON POLICE OFFICERS, RESISTING ARREST AND CONSPIRACY TO COMMIT OBSCENITY.

OFFICERS SAID LEWD FILMS WERE SHOWN AT THE GATHERING AND PROSTITUTES WERE PRESENT. THREE WOMEN WERE ARRESTED.

AN ATTORNEY FOR HAGGERTY, SECOND-RANKING CRIMINAL JUDGE IN NEW ORLEANS, TOLD NEWSMEN THE GATHERING WAS A BACHELOR PARTY IN HONOR OF A FRIEND WHO WAS TO BE MARRIED. NEWSMEN WERE INVITED TO ACCOMPANY OFFICERS ON THE WEDNESDAY NIGHT RAID, A COMMON PRACTICE IN NEW ORLEANS.

HAGGERTY HAS NOT BROKEN HIS SILENCE ON THE MATTER.

GARRISON HAS THE OPTION OF CHARGING HAGGERTY DIRECTLY OR OF SUBMITTING THE CASE TO THE GRAND JURY. SOURCES CLOSE TO THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY SAID HE WOULD SEND IT TO THE GRAND JURY.
