WASHINGTON (UPI) -- A RETIRED CENTRAL INTELLIGENCE AGENCY OFFICIAL WHO HAS STARTED A CAMPAIGN TO DEFEND THE AGENCY SAYS HE AGREES WITH CUBAN FREMIER FIDEL CASTRO ON ONE THING; CUEA HAD NOTHING TO DO WITH THE JOHN KENNEDY ASSASSINATION.

DAVID PHILLIPS, WHO WAS WITH THE CIA FOR 24 YEARS, NOTED AT A NEWS CONFERENCE SATURDAY THAT CASTRO HAS RECENTLY DENIED CUEAN IMPLICATION IN THE ASSASSINATION.

"FOR THE FIRST TIME I AGREE WITH CASTRO," PHILLIPS SAID. THE EARY OF PIGS OPERATION. HE SAID THAT LEE HARVEY OSWALD WAS UNDOUGHEDLY THE SOLE KILLER.

OSWALD'S FREVIOUS DEFECTION TO THE SOVIET UNION AND HIS APPROACHES TO THE CUEANS HAVE LED TO PERSISTENT ALLEGATIONS THAT SOMEHOW MOSCOW AND HAVANA WERE INVOLVED IN THE KENNEDY KILLING.

BUT FHILLIPS SAID THAT THE CUEANS AND RUSSIANS "REGARDED OSWALD AS A KOOK AND DIDN'T WANT ANYTHING TO DO WITH HIM."

HE SAID THAT WHEN OSWALD APPLIED AT THE SOVIET AND CUEAN EMEASSIES IN MEXICO CITY FOR VISAS TO THOSE COUNTRIES IN SEPTEMBER, 1963 "HE FIN CONVINCED HE WENT EACK AND DID IT HIMSELF." PHILLIPS SAID.

PHILLIPS SAID HE HAS WRITTEN TO ABOUT 400 OTHER FORMER

INTELLIGENCE OFFICERS ASKING SUPPORT FOR HIS PUBLIC RELATIONS EFFORT ON BEHALF OF THE CIA AND THAT GO OF THEM HAVE JOINED HIS GROUP.

MENTALLY UNSTABLE AND POSSIBLY A "SLEEPER" AMERICAN AGENT, THAT THEY
TRIED TO GET HIM OUT OF THE COUNTRY AND VETOED HIS RETURN WHEN HE
APPLIED IN MEXICO CITY IN SEPTEMBER, 1963.

SCHORR SAID NONE OF THE NOSENKO INFORMATION WAS INCLUDED IN THE
FINAL WARREN COMMISSION REPORT, BUT THAT IT HAD RECENTLY BEEN
DECLASSIFIED. HE SAID FORMER CIA DIRECTOR JOHN MCCONE SAYS NOSENKO'S
CLAIMS LATER WERE VERIFIED TO THE CIA'S SATISFACTION.
