### Police in Dallas Queried on JFK Slaying

DALLAS — J. Gordon Shanklin, special agent in charge of the Dallas office of the FBI, said yesterday the Rockefeller Commission has asked the FBI to help question local police officers in connection with the assassination of President John F. Kennedy.

Shanklin said the commission's request did not originate with his office but involved an FBI photographic expert from Washington and a local agent. The expert arrived in town several weeks ago and questioned officers who were in Dealey Plaza the day Kennedy was killed.

"The Rockefeller Commission asked us to assist in this," he said. "If they reopen the investigation, I don't know who they'll have to do it."
