The gun was altered as follows: Barrel out off to two and one-half inches and original round sight replaced on shorter barrel, rechambered to .38 Special, the converter having stamped on the left side of frame, "Cal. .38 Special," and the suivel in the butt having been filled. The gun has original type grips.

Company, Inc., 1225 South Grand Avenue, Los Angeles, advised SA W. JAMES WOOD on 11/30/63 that the above gun was one of
