**Result of examination:**

This slip of paper was removed from the wallet of **LEE HARVEY OSWALD**.

It was concluded that **LEE HARVEY OSWALD**, K4 and K5 in this case, prepared the hand printing on Q65 except for the one word in Russian appearing on the side of Q65 which was the address of the Embassy of the U.S.S.R. thereon.

Specimen Q65 is retained.
