Field of Details

Based on the comparison of the rifle held by Lee Harvey Oswald shown in the submitted photograph with photographs of the rifle ^{which is available in the labors} recovered at the scene of the assassination, it has been determined that the guns shown in these photographs are similar in all respects and, based on one unusual accidental characteristic, that these photographs probably depict the same gun.
