On December 30, 1963, Supervisor W. R. Wannall forwarded the evidence listed below to the Laboratory together with a letter from the United States Information Agency (USIA) pertaining to the submitted evidence.

Q350^A Airmail envelope addressed to the Voice of America postmarked Habana, Cuba, 6 p.m., DIC 3 1963

Q351 Accompanying typewritten letter headed La Habana 27 De Noviembre 1963 bearing salutation "Senores" and ending with the typewritten and handwritten signature "Miguel Galban Lopez"

It was concluded that the typewriting on Q350^A and Q351 was prepared on the typewriter used to prepare specimens Q232 through Q235 previously submitted.

It was noted that the envelope Q350^A is the same kind as the envelope Q232 and Q234 and the paper of Q351 is the same kind as Q235.

The signature on Q351 is not comparable with the signatures on Q233 and Q235.

No indented writing was found on Q350^A and Q351.

It was noted that the envelope Q350^A had been previously opened and revealed as were Q232 and Q234.

It was noted that the date of the letter Q351 is the same as the date of the letter Q235.

Q232 through Q235 were two letters previously submitted both bearing Cuban postmarks.
