Reurairtel 2-26-64 setting forth results of your inquiries in connection with the Rambler Motel, Waskon, Texas, and your interview of Mrs. Ruth Paine in such matter.

Enclosed herewith is a photographic copy of the registration card executed by Mrs. Paine when she stayed at the Rambler Motel, September 23, 1963. The Bureau has furnished two copies of the enclosure to the President's Commission and is retaining one copy of the enclosure for the Bureau file in this matter. Accordingly, it will not be necessary for you to attach this particular item to a future report prepared by your office in this matter.

You will note that the FBI Laboratory has assigned evidence number B-147 to this item. The original of the registration card is being retained by the FBI Laboratory along with other evidence in this case. The Bureau has noted that Mr. Mike Carrier, of the Rambler Motel, desires this card be returned to him when it is no longer needed.

When Mrs. Paine moved Marina Oswald from New Orleans to Irving, Texas, 9-23-63 she and Marina stayed at a motel in Texas near the Louisiana border. The Commission requested we identify the motel and the exact date involved, since such data would assist the Commission in ascertaining time of certain actions of Lee Harvey Oswald. We have furnished results of our inquiries to the Commission by letter 3-2-64 and by letter 3-11-64. We are furnishing Commission photographic copies of the registration card of Mrs. Paine at the Rambler Motel. Enclosure being furnished Dallas for its file concerning Oswald.
