**Q580 Envelope (postmark illegible), bearing typewritten address "Mr. J. Edgar Hoover Federal Bureau of Investigation Washington, D. C.," and accompanying two-page typewritten letter headed "Federal Bureau of Investigation Washington, D. C." beginning "Gentlemen: A while back I overheard..." and ending "...people in public office. Sincerely, A Citizen" (u)**

**Result of examination:**

**The typewriting on Q580 was not identified in the Anonymous Letter File. A photograph of this exhibit will be added to this file. (u)**

**The typewriting on Q580 matches most closely the Laboratory standard for a Corona pica style of type, spaced ten letters per inch. (u)**

**The envelope and paper comprising Q580 does not contain any watermarks, indented writings, or other significant features which would indicate the source of the paper. (u)**

**The postmark on the envelope in Q580 appears to be "ALBUQUERQUE TR 8 MAY 15 1964 P M," although the "ALBUQUERQUE" portion of the postmark is quite faint. (u)**

**You will be separately advised on the latent fingerprint examination of Q580. (u)**
