Enclosed for further information of Dallas is copy of Legat, Mexico City, 8/31/64 letter requesting the above-described examinations.

Dallas report results of Laboratory's 4/9/64 examination in report to be submitted. In describing specimen 173 state that the specimen was a sample from a passenger manifest of Transportes Transported Pronters used for purpose of recording thereon the 18/2/63 date stamp in use at the Mexico City terminal of the bus line. Also explain that specimen K74, described as a block of forms of Transported Pronters Bus Company, is bound together at the top in pad form by A gum-type substance. Also report that according to confidential source abroad, specimen K74 was found by Transportes Fronters tichet salesman and simpatcher, Francisco Alvarado, on a lover shelf in the Mexico City baggage terminal of that company and that he believed the questioned manifest Q332 was located by the manager of the terminal, Gilberto Lomano Guinar, and torn from the block of forms for delivery to the Mexican authorities who retrieved it at the bus terminal.

believed to have been on this bus and, therefore, thushas been some doubt as to the authenticity of the manifest. Mexico City has located the padded block of manifests fine which Q 332 was apparently torm. Laboratory states that indented writings and other extraneous marks on the questioned manifest and on the top sheet in the pad of manifests indicates the questioned manifest was eriginally on top of the present top sheet in the pad. It is of interest that Laboratory has found on the present top page of the pad fragmentary indented writing on 16 out of 19 lines in the body of the manifest. One of the lines in which there is no observable indented writing is the line with the entry "Oswid." Other writings on this manifest by the man who made this entry show indentations on the present top sheet of the pad. While an examination of this sort cannot conclusively establish that the "Oswid" entry was written after the manifest was torn from the pad and, therefore, probably after the assassination. The examination nevertheless, shows that such could have been the case.
