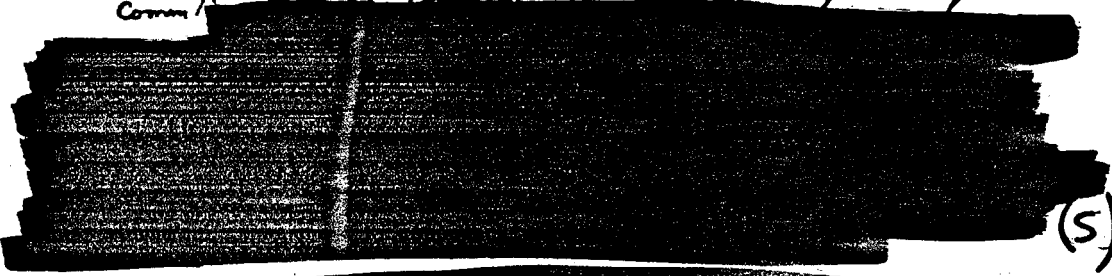
Attached is copy of Anchorage airtel dated 8/13/64 with enclosures thereto. Enclosures consist of 23 letters in 22 envelopes which should be considered known handwriting of Anita (Annette) May Setyaeva, nee Zugoff. Also included in enclosures in the long envelope is a small note written on both sides of paper in red ink. This should be regarded as known specimen of writing of Lev (Leo) Setyaev. Name and address of Setyaev appears on page 63 of Oswald's address book (Exhibit B-29). (u)

Would you do the following in connection with this material: (u)

(1) Compare known writing of Setyaev in enclosure with writings on page 63 of B-29 and with English script in Exhibits D-119, D-120 and Exhibits 245 and 248. (u)

*Comm 51* (2) Compare Russian script in Exhibits 129, 131, 150, 356, 358 and 361 with writings on page 63 of B-29. *Comm 38* *Comm 41* (u)



(5) Check the writings relating to Setyaev on page 63 of B-29 with the known writings of Oswald and Marina Oswald. *- note writing on 1st line of pg 63 - Is this Oswald's. It looks like Oswald wrote Setyaev name & connection with Radio Moscow & that someone else then re-wrote this material for him, possibly Setyaev.* (S)

(6) Make a formal D- exhibit of Lev Setyaev's writing. (u)

Please furnish the usual number of copies of the D- exhibit regarding Setyaev's writing to me and direct Laboratory report to Domestic Intelligence Division with copy designated for Dallas. I will send the report and exhibit to Dallas and will advise Commission. (u)
